
Frisian draughts



A short explanation



The board

The game has the same board as international draughts, moving goas the same way.

The game can also be played with 5 pieces each from the baseline. (FRYSK!)

Capturing

Capturing goes diagonally, vertically and horizontally. During one stroke each piece can only be hit once.

White captures from 45 (via 25 and 14) to 12.

Capturing, highest shot value

During a capture higest shot applies. But there is a difference between the value of pieces. A king has a higher value than a man but less than 2 men.

White has to capture from 45 to 5.

Capturing with the king

A king may also capture in 8 directions and does not have to be left behind after a captured piece.

If a piece and a king can simultaneously capture the same value of pieces, the capturing with the king is mandatory.

White has to capture from 3 to 26.

Moving a king

A king can play a move up to three times in a row, after which it can only may capture or a move or capture with another piece is allowed. After that the king is free again.

Wins 2 kings against 1 king? Yes! But the player has only 7 moves to decide the game in favor. If it fails to win, then it's a draw, as is the case with 1 king against 1 king.
